The State Barrier Fence stretches for 1170km, from the Zuytdorp Cliffs north of Kalbarri, to the Ravensthorpe-Esperance Road. The primary reason for the Fence is the exclusion of emus from the agricultural areas of the state. Rabbit proof fences built at the turn of the century have now been upgraded and form part of this extensive fence. Agriculture WA has a proud tradition of maintaining these fences for nearly 100 years.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. No firearms are to be used while travelling along the State Barrier Fence reserve (20 metres wide).
2. All gates that form part of the State Barrier Fence are to be closed once passed through
3. All station gates adjoining the State Barrier Fence are to be left as found.
4. The permit holder is to avoid travelling along the State Barrier Fence reserve during or after rain.
5. The permit holder must not interfere with any Departmental watering points.
6. Avoid driving emus and other wildlife into the State Barrier Fence.
7. Any damage caused to the fence or track by the permit holder or any other person travelling with the permit holder ("permitted persons") must be repaired as completely as is possible and such damage must be reported back to Agriculture Western Australia.
8. The permit holder and all permitted persons travel along the State Barrier Fence reserve at their own risk and the permit holder hereby indemnifies and agrees to keep indemnified the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Agriculture, the Agriculture Protection Board and the Crown in right of the State of Western Australia (hereinafter referred to collectively and/or individually as "the State") against all loss of or damage to property of the State and from and against any claim, demand, action, suit or proceeding that may be brought by any person against the State arising out of or as a consequence of any act or omission by the permit holder or the permitted persons in relation to their travel along the State Barrier Fence.
